New Applications and TIP Revisions

Ottumwa - North Court Street Reconstruction: City is applying for \$2,563,960 in SWAP funds to be programmed in FY27 for the PCC reconstruction of N Court Street between Park Ave and Vogel. Work will include a bus lane by Horace Mann school and a multi-use path. *Dimmit made a motion to approve, Wood seconded the motion.* All aye, motion passed.

Fairfield – Bus 34 over West Crow Creek: City is applying for an additional \$660,000 in SWAP funds for the bridge replacement over West Crow Creek. Project is programmed in FY24 and includes trail improvements. *Dimmit made a motion to approve, Johnson seconded the motion.* All aye, motion passed.

Approval of the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program: The 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program contains all federal aid and SWAP projects within the region for the next four years. *Wood made a motion to approve, Dimmit seconded the motion.* All aye, motion passed.

Discussion Items

Long-Range Transportation Plan Goals DRAFT

- 1. Maintain a transportation system in a state of good repair for users and a system that is safe with good mobility by encouraging projects that:
 - a. Improving deficient roads based on their condition, traffic volume, and population.
 - b. Improving bridges based on their condition so they are safe for use.
 - c. Incorporating safety improvements into projects, especially in areas crash histories.
 - d. Reducing vehicle, freight, transit, rail, bicycle and pedestrian conflicts.
 - e. Improving travel times or level of service.
- 2. Promote an efficient means of meeting the transportation needs of the region by:
 - a. Maximizing the useful life of existing transportation infrastructure.
 - b. Discouraging projects with high costs and low use.
 - c. Identifying federal, state and local sources to assist with the funding of projects.
 - d. Encouraging cooperation between governments on projects that benefit more than one agency.
- 3. Encourage economic development in the region by:
 - a. Giving consideration to and promoting transportation projects that create or retain jobs in the region.
 - b. Developing connections between existing developments, new developments and/or redevelopments.
 - c. Improving connectivity between cities or regions.
- 4. Promote and maintain public transportation as affordable, available and accessible, look for ways to improve service by:
 - a. Ensuring that fixed routes are rider friendly.
 - b. Coordinating with area hospitals to assist people in getting home after a trip to the Emergency Room.
 - c. Look for opportunities to expand service into the evening/night for people who work later so people can use transit for shopping/leisure activities.
- 5. Promote and develop nonmotorized transportation, including bicycle and pedestrian facilities both to enhance quality of life and mobility by:
 - a. Expanding and improving access to trails.
 - b. Developing a regional trail system.
 - c. Developing safe trails and improving the safety of existing trails.
